



# SAFETYVIIIII

- This product is intended for single-family residential use only, by children ages two to ten and a maximum weight of 105 pounds. Any recommendation over 10 years of age or 105 pounds exceeds the upper limits specified in the American Society for Testing and Materials (ASTM) Home Playground Safety Standard. In order for PlayStar to comply with the ASTM Standard, we cannot recommend anyone above these limits.
- It is a misuse of this product when installed or used in places of public assembly such as schools or parks.

- Follow the instructions provided, do not alter its design in any way.
- Construction requires at least two adults capable of heavy lifting.
- Thoroughly read all safety instructions before beginning.
- Children must remain clear of construction site until this product is properly installed and ready for use.
- Save these instructions in the event the manufacturer has to be contacted.

# The Consumer Product Safety Commission provides the following consumer information for your Home Playground Equipment

#### **Select Protective Surfacing**

One of the most important things you can do to reduce the likelihood of serious head injuries is to install shock-absorbing protective surfacing under and around your play equipment. The protective surfacing should be applied to a depth that is suitable for the equipment height in accordance with ASTM F1292. There are different types of surfacing to choose from; whichever product you select, follow these guidelines:

NOTE: Do not install home playground equipment over concrete, asphalt, packed earth, grass, carpet or any other hard surface. A fall onto a hard surface can result in serious injury or death to the equipment user. Grass and dirt are not considered protective surfacing because wear and environmental factors can reduce their shock absorbing effectiveness. Carpeting and thin mats are generally not adequate protective surfacing. Ground level equipment -- such as a sandbox, activity wall, playhouse or other equipment that has no elevated play surface -- does not need any protective surfacing.

#### **Loose-Fill Materials**

PlayStar Playsets require fall-height protection from eight feet.

 Maintain a <u>minimum depth</u> of 9 inches of loose-fill materials such as wood mulch / chips, engineered wood fiber (EWF), or shredded/recycled rubber mulch for equipment up to 8 feet high. NOTE: An initial fill level of 12 inches will compress to about a 9-inch depth of surfacing over time. The surfacing will also compact, displace, and settle, and should be periodically refilled to maintain at least a 9-inch depth.

- Use containment, such as digging out around the perimeter and/or lining the perimeter with landscape edging. Don't forget to account for water drainage.
- Check and maintain the depth of the loose-fill surfacing material. To maintain the right amount of loose-fill materials, mark the correct level on play equipment support posts. That way you can easily see when to replenish and/or redistribute the surfacing.
- <u>Do not</u> install loose fill surfacing over hard surfaces such as concrete or asphalt.

#### Poured-In-Place Surfaces or Pre-Manufactured Rubber Tiles

You may be interested in using surfacing other than loose-fill materials -- like rubber tiles or poured-in-place surfaces.

- Installations of these surfaces generally require a professional and are not "do- it-yourself" projects.
- Review surface specifications before purchasing this type of surfacing. Ask the installer/manufacturer for a report showing that the product has been tested to the following safety standard: ASTM F1292 Standard Specification for Impact Attenuation of Surfacing Materials within the Use Zone of Playground Equipment. This report should show the specific height for which the surface is intended to protect against serious head injury.


This height should be equal to or greater than the *fall height* - vertical distance between a designated play surface (elevated surface for standing, sitting, or climbing) and the protective surfacing below - of your play equipment.

 Check the protective surfacing frequently for wear.

#### **Placement**

Proper placement and maintenance of protective surfacing is essential. Be sure to:

- Extend surfacing at least 6 feet from the equipment in all directions.
- For to-fro swings, extend protective surfacing in front of and behind the swing to a distance equal to twice the height of the top bar from which the swing is suspended.





- 1. Follow the instructions provided, do not alter its design in any way.
- 2. Place the equipment on level ground, not less than 6' (1.8m) from any structure or obstruction such as a fence, garage, house, overhanging branches, laundry lines or electrical wires. If the area where you will be installing your playset is not level, you must make it level.
- Playsets must be anchored to the ground. Follow the anchoring instructions provided with your building kit. If soil conditions permit anchors to be pulled out easily, such as in sandy soil conditions, cementing is required.
- 4. Tighten all bolts securely to the intended member then cut off all protruding threaded ends of bolts with a hack saw flush to the end of the nut and remove sharp edges with a metal file.

**WARNING:** Children must not use the playset until properly installed and proper shock-absorbing surfacing material is in place.

**OPERATION:** Observing and following statements and warnings reduces the likelihood of serious or fatal injury.

On-site adult supervision is recommended for children of all ages.

 Only one child, for each single planned seat or single planned activity should be allowed on this set at one time, with a maximum weight of <u>105 pounds</u> for each child.

**WARNING:** You must teach children the following:

- A. **Not** to walk close to, in front of, behind, or between moving items.
- B. <u>Not</u> to twist swing chains or ropes or loop them over the top support bar since this may reduce the strength of the chain or rope.
- C. Avoid swinging empty seats.
- D. **To Sit** in the center of the swings with their full weight on the seats.
- E. <u>Not</u> to use the equipment in a manner other than intended.
- F. Not to get off equipment while it is in motion.
- G. Not to climb when equipment is wet.
- H. <u>Not</u> to attach items to the playground equipment that are not specifically designed for use with the equipment such as, but not limited to, jump ropes, clothesline, pet leashes, cables and chain as they may cause a strangulation hazard.
- Remove bike or other sports helmet before playing on the playground equipment.
- Verify that suspended climbing ropes are secured at both ends and that they cannot be looped back on themselves.

- 4. Dress children appropriately and do not allow them to wear inappropriate items, such as but not limited to, loose fitting clothing, hood and neck draw strings, scarves, cord-connected items, capes, and ponchos. These items can cause death by strangulation. Provide wellfitting and full enclosure footwear. Examples of inappropriate footwear are clogs, flip flops, and sandals.
- Verify that all suspended swinging components have at least 8" clearance between the lowest point of component and top of shock-absorbing surfacing material.

WARNING: Lawn swings are designed for use by children two years of age and older. Use by children under the age of two can result in entrapment between the seat and backrest. NEVER place children in a rearward facing position or with legs between the seat and backrest because the child's body may pass through the opening causing entrapment of the child's head.

#### **DISPOSAL:**

When the playset is to be retired from service, disassemble and dispose of in such a way that no unreasonable hazards will exist. Follow your local disposal requirements.



## **BOARDS INCLUDED**

Before starting to assemble your playset. make sure all boards and hardware are identified and stacked by size. This will improve your assembly time.


All boards are identified by "nominal" dimensions. The "actual" width and thickness of boards will vary. During assembly process, hide the marked end of the board to the inside so it is not visible on your completed playset.

Lumber is a natural product. Imperfections such as surface cracks, knots, and minor bowing are normal. This will not affect the performance of your playset.

Thinner boards have a tendency to bow more than thicker boards. However, all minor bowing can be straightened when attaching the boards during the assembly process.






## TEMPLATE and DRILLING INSTRUCTIONS

Your building kit includes a **Drill Template** and an **Assembly Tool Kit** to help you create some of the pilot holes needed to build your playset.


Position the template and mark only the holes that need to be drilled according to the patterns shown below. Remove the template before drilling.

WARNING: Do not drill holes through the template as you may damage the template.



Set the drill bit depth in the ½" drill bit/countersink tool to the thickness of the board. (Fig. 1)


Drill locations as marked.



Warning: Do not countersink deeper than the depth of the screw head.

In the assembly instructions, you will be asked to attach the countersunk and predrilled boards with #8 x  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " deck screws.

To make this process easier, use the predrilled boards as templates for drilling pilot holes into the second boards. (Fig. 2)




Note: A second drill will make this process easier by eliminating multiple changes between drill bit and counersink tool.


### PLEASE NOTE: Letters represent pattern not position

Note: When the PlayStar logo is showing, the three tabs on the bottom will position the template square with any two edges. When the arrow is showing, the two tabs on the bottom will position the template square with one edge only, which will allow you to slide the template anywhere along the board.

The rigid version of the template like the one shown here can be found inside one of the hardware boxes.




**Actual Size Template** 



Patterns **DEFC** and **J** can be created anywhere along the board by turning the template over (arrow side up) and sliding it to the desired position. Use the shaded holes for that pattern.





## ATTACHING CORNER BRACKETS

There are several steps in the assembly of your playset when you will be asked to attach "corner brackets". Please review these diagrams to understand where to place the brackets, how to attach them, and what hardware to use.

#### **POSITIONING THE BRACKETS:**

The "corner bracket" has one long side and one short side. The holes on the long side of the bracket are placed so that when you position the bracket correctly, as directed throughout these instructions, the bolt will be almost centered in the middle of the vertical 2" x 4" when installed. (See diagram)






Caution: If the bracket was flipped and the short side was against the double board when you drilled, the holes will be too close to the edge of the vertical 2" x 4".

#### ATTACHING AND SECURING THE BRACKETS:


- 1. Hold bracket in position and use the bracket as a drill guide. Use a 1/8" drill bit and drill through the small holes 1" deep into the boards.
- 2. Attach the bracket with #8 x 11/4" deck screws.
- 3. Again use the bracket as a drill guide. Use a 3/8" drill bit and drill through the large holes completely through the boards.
- 4. Secure the bracket with %" hex bolts, %" washers, and %" lock nuts as shown.

Note: You will use different length bolts to secure the corner brackets.

- If you drilled through <u>one</u> board you will need to use a %" x 2" hex bolt.
- If you drilled through two boards you will need to use a %" x 3½" hex bolt



Securing through one board use \(^3\mathbb{8}''\) x 2" hex bolt.



Securing through two boards use \[ \frac{3}{8}\] x \[ 3\frac{1}{2}\] hex bolt.

## **TOWER ASSEMBLY**

# (2) 2" x 4" x 88" boards (4) 2" x 4" x 38¾" boards (16) #8 x 2½" deck screws 75½" A 75½" On a flat work surface,

lay out two 2" x 4" x 88" boards 38¾" apart. Measure and mark both boards at dimensions shown.

Attach four 2" x 4" x  $38\frac{3}{4}$ " boards as shown. Make sure the assembly remains square while securing with #8 x  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " deck screws.



#### Items for STEP 2:

- (2) 2" x 4" x 751/4" boards
- (3) 2" x 4" x 383/4" boards
- (12) #8 x 21/2" deck screws

On a flat work surface, lay out two 2" x 4" x  $75\frac{1}{4}$ " boards  $38\frac{3}{4}$ " apart. Measure and mark both boards at dimensions shown.

Attach three 2" x 4" x 38%" boards as shown. Make sure the assembly remains square while securing with #8 x 2%" deck screws.




#### Items for STEP 3:

- (6) 2" x 4" x 463/4" boards
- (36) #8 x 21/2" deck screws

Stand tower frames on their sides as shown.

Attach six 2" x 4" x  $46\frac{3}{4}$ " boards at the dimensions shown. Make sure the assembly remains square while securing with #8 x  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " deck screws.



#### Items for STEP 4:

- (8) Corner Brackets
- (32) #8 x 11/4" deck screws
- (8) 3/8" x 31/2" hex bolts
- (6) %" x 2" hex bolts
- (2) 3/8" x 11/2" lag screws
- (30) 3/8" washers
- (14) 3/8" lock nuts

Lift tower assembly upright and position in desired location.

Caution: Ground must be level.
Installation on a hill or incline
will create unsafe conditions.


Position brackets 1 through 3 so that the short sides are against the 2" x 4" x 38¾" boards.

Use the bracket as a drill guide and drill  $\frac{1}{8}$ " holes 1" deep into the boards. Attach with #8 x  $\frac{1}{4}$ " deck screws.

Bracket 1 through 6 ONLY: Use bracket as a drill guide and drill %" holes completely through the boards. Secure with %" hex bolts (2" through one board and 3½" through two boards), %" washers and %" lock nuts.

#### Special Instructions for Brackets **@**&**@** ONLY:

Use bracket as a drill guide and drill one %" hole completely through the board on the **long** side and one 1" hole 1" deep into the board on the **short** side. Secure the **long** side with a 1" x 1" hex bolt, 1" washers and 1" lock nut. Secure the **short** side with a 1" x 1" lag screw and 1" washer.





#### Items for STEP 5:

- (1) 2" x 4" x 463/4" board
- (4) #8 x 21/2" deck screws

Predrill the 2" x 4" x 38¾" boards at the dimension shown.

Center the 2" x 4" x 46%" board behind the holes and flush with the top of the 2" x 4" x 38%" boards. Secure with #8 x 2% deck screws.

#### **Items for STEP 6:**


- (15) 1" x 4" x 35%" boards
- (90) #8 x 11/2" deck screws

Attach fifteen pre-drilled and counter-sank 1" x 4" x 357/8" boards.

Attach the front and back boards flush with the 2" x 4" x 38%" boards and equally space the remaining boards. Secure all boards with #8 x 1%" deck screws. Do not over tighten the screws.

Note: Gap between boards must be less than 1/4" or a finger entrapment could exist.


Caution: Failure to pre-drill and counter-sink the boards may result in split lumber.



#### Items for STEP 7:

- (2) 2" x 4" x 88" boards
- (20) #8 x 21/2" deck screws


Attach two 2" x 4" x 88" boards at dimensions shown. Secure with #8 x  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " deck screws.



#### **Items for STEP 8:**

- (2) 2" x 4" x 463/4" boards
- (8) #8 x 21/2" deck screws


Attach two pre-drilled 2" x 4" x 46%" boards at the dimensions shown. Center boards on tower, there should be a 4" overhang on each end of the boards. Make sure the top of the board is flush while securing with #8 x 2%" deck screws.



#### Items for STEP 9:

- (2) 2" x 4" x 311/2" boards
- (8) #8 x 21/2" deck screws

Attach two pre-drilled 2" x 4" x 31½" boards at dimensions shown. Center boards on tower, there should an overhang on each end of the boards. Make sure the top and bottom of board is flush while securing with #8 x 21/2" deck screws.




#### Items for STEP 10:

- (2) 2" x 4" x 241/4" boards
- (1) 2" x 4" x 311/2" boards
- (12) #8 x 21/2" deck screws

Attach two 2" x 4" x 241/4" boards centered in the tower as shown. Secure with #8 x 21/2" deck screws.


Attach one pre-drilled 2" x 4" x 311/2" boards at dimensions shown. Make sure there is an overhang of 13/4" on each end of the 2" x 4" x 241/4" boards as shown. Secure with #8 x 21/2" deck screws.




## **SWING BEAM ASSEMBLY**

#### Items for STEP 11:

- (6) 2" x 4" x 88" boards
- (48) #8 x 21/2" deck screws



Note: Repeat two more times for the second and third swing post assemblies.



#### Items for STEP 12:

- (3) Step 11 Assemblies
- (2) Right-hand Sturdy-frame Brackets
- (1) Left-hand Sturdy-frame Bracket
- (6) #8 x 11/4" deck screws
- (6) 3/8" x 31/2" hex bolts
- (12) 3/8" washers
- (6) 3/8" lock nuts


Attach two right-hand (R) and one left-hand (L) sturdy-frame brackets onto separate swing post assemblies (brackets are stamped R and L).

Lay bracket on the flush end of post as shown. Slide bracket over and down until it stops against the top and side of the post as shown. When correctly positioned, the edge of the sturdy-frame bracket will be parallel with the side of the post. Use the bracket as a drill guide and drill two  $\frac{1}{8}$ " holes 1" deep into the posts. Attach with two #8 x  $\frac{1}{4}$ " deck screws.


Again use the bracket as a drill guide and drill two %" holes through the post. Secure bracket with two %" x 3½" hex bolts, %" washers and %" lock nuts.

Repeat for each post.

Caution: Make sure bolts are tight and the threads of each bolt are at least flush to the end of the nut to ensure proper engagement.



Left-hand shown




Rear View of bracket and post assembly showing correct position.

#### Items for STEP 13:

- (2) 3/8" x 3/4" hex bolts
- (2) 3/8" lock nuts

Mate one right-hand bracket assembly to one left-hand bracket assembly as shown.

Secure with two  $\frac{3}{8}$ " x  $\frac{3}{4}$ " hex bolts and  $\frac{3}{8}$ " lock nuts through the two lower holes of brackets as shown (do not use flat washers).




#### Items for STEP 14:

- (2) 3/8" x 3/4" hex bolts
- (2) 3/8" lock nuts

Place two %" x %" hex bolts and %" lock nuts through the two lower holes of bracket on single post as shown (do not use flat washers).

Note: These bolts are necessary to properly align the single post assembly to beam at a later step.




#### Items for STEP 15:

- (1) 2" x 4" x 463/4" board
- (4) #8 x 21/2" deck screws

Position assembly as shown.

Align the posts so that the outermost points measure 84¾" as shown.

Attach 2" x 4" x 46¾" board at dimension shown. Secure with #8 x 2½" deck screws.



#### Items for STEP 16:

- (2) corner brackets
- (8) #8 x 11/4" screws
- (2) 3/8" x 31/2" hex bolts
- (2) 3/8" x 2" hex bolts
- (8) 3/8" washers
- (4) 3/8" lock nuts


**Attach corner brackets.** To complete the A-Frame Assembly, flip over as shown and position brackets so that the short side is against the 2" x 4" x 46¾" board.

Use the bracket as a drill guide and drill  $\frac{1}{8}$ " holes 1" deep into the board. Attach with #8 x  $\frac{11}{4}$ " deck screws.

Again use the bracket as a drill guide and drill %" holes completely through the boards. Secure with %" hex bolts, %" washers and %" lock nuts.

NOTE: If you are bolting through one board use a %" x 2" hex bolt.

If you are bolting through two boards, use a \%" x 3\\%" hex bolt.



## **Swing Station Assembly**

#### Items for STEP 17:


- (1) 2" x 6" x 88" board
- (1) 2" x 6" x 35%" board
- (4) #8 x 11/4" deck screws

Lay out the single post assembly and the A-Frame assembly approximately 92½" apart. Use remaining unused boards to elevate approximately 3".

Place 2" x 6" x 88" and 2" x 6" x 35%" beam boards under brackets as shown.

Use brackets as a drill guide and drill  $\frac{1}{8}$ " holes 1" deep into the beam and attach with #8 x  $\frac{1}{4}$ " deck screws as shown.

Again, use brackets as a drill guide and drill %" holes completely through the beam as shown.




#### Items for STEP 18:

- (1) 2" x 6" x 88" board
- (1) 2" x 6" x 35%" board
- (16) #8 x 21/2" deck screws


Predrill the 2" x 6" x 88" and 2" x 6" x 35%" beam boards at the dimension shown. (See Pages 7 & 8 "How To Use Your Drill Template For Drill Holes" for details.)

Attach the drilled 2" x 6" x 88" and 2" x 6" x 35%" board on top of the existing assembly as shown. Make sure boards are flush with bottom board. Secure boards together with #8 x 2% screws.

Note: If your boards are a different length, flush the end with the single post.

- (6) swing hangers
- (6) 3/8" x 3" lag screws
- (6) 3/8" washers


Mark the top beam board, on the bottom edge, at the dimensions shown, for swing hanger locations.

## NOTE: If you are installing the Air Rider, follow the installation instructions that are supplied with the Air Rider.

Drill a 1/4" hole 21/2" deep in the center of the bottom board at each swing hanger location.

Screw swing hangers into beam by hand (a long screwdriver will help). Tighten swing hanger until loop is tight against adjoining board and swing hanger is positioned as shown.

Drill another  $\frac{1}{4}$ " hole  $\frac{21}{2}$ " deep in adjoining board through swing hanger loop and secure each swing hanger with one  $\frac{3}{8}$ " x 3" lag screw and  $\frac{3}{8}$ " washer.



## **CONNECT TOWER AND SWING BEAM**


#### Items for STEP 21:

- (1) 3/8" x 41/2" bolt
- (2) 3/8" washers
- (1) 3/8" lock nut

On the post of tower assembly where the beam will be attached, measure and mark hole location (7" down and 15%" from edge) as shown. (Fig. 1)

Drill a %" hole completely through the board.


On the open hole of the beam assembly use a  $1\frac{1}{8}$ " spade bit and counterbore approximately  $\frac{1}{4}$ " deep to ensure that the threads of the bolt are at least flush to the end of the nut when installed. (Fig. 2)



#### Items for STEP 22:

- (2) 2" x 4" x 241/4" boards
- (6) #8 x 2½" deck screws


Attach two 2" x 4" x 241/4" boards as shown. The back of the boards must be flush with the 2" x 4" x 88" boards and the top must be flush with the bottom of the 2" x 4" x 463/4" board. Make sure boards are level while securing with #8 x 21/2" deck screws.




#### Items for STEP 23:

- (1) 2" x 6" x 12" board
- (4) #8 x 21/2" deck screws

Screw the anchor deep enough so that the center of the loop at the top of the anchor will be approximately 3½" off ground when wall is in the final position.

- 5. Reinstall Climbing Wall permanently, attaching it to play deck using #14 x 11/4" pan head screws provided.
- 6. Use the anchor as a drill guide and drill a %" hole completely through the Climbing Wall. Attach Climbing Wall to anchor with one %" x 11/4" hex bolt, two %" washers and one %" lock nut provided in the anchor kit. (Fig. 2)

Warning: Failure to anchor the Climbing Wall properly could cause serious injury from children lifting the Unit.






#### **SWING SEAT • GYM RINGS**

- 1. Attach coated ends of chains onto play component using Quick-Link Connectors provided. <u>Tighten securely</u> with an adjustable wrench.
- 2. Hook uncoated ends of chain onto Swing Hangers provided.
- 3. Customize the height of your **swing** or **gym rings** anywhere in the *Adjustment Zone*, to fit your child.

Warning: Failure to tighten Quick Links securely could result in injury.







Swing Chain Spacing:


10" minimum spacing is required from the closest point of all other rides or stationary objects.


Gym Ring Chain Spacing:

111/2" minimum spacing is required from the closest point of all other rides or stationary objects.

#### **CLIMBING ROPE**

- 1. Tie five knots, equally spaced, for climbing grips. (Fig. 1)
- 2. Insert rope through top hole and tie a knot with 4" remaining.
- 3. Insert opposite end through bottom hole, pull tight and tie a knot while keeping rope snug.
- 4. Secure both ends with staples provided (2 each end). (Fig. 2)

#### **PLAY HANDLES**

- 1. Position Play Handle at desired location.
- 2. Mark pilot holes.
- 3. Drill 1/8" holes 1" deep.
- 4. Secure with #14 x 11/4" pan head screws provided.




#### **DISCOVERY TELESCOPE**

- 1. Determine desired location for pivot.
- 2. Drill a 1/8" diameter hole 1" deep.
- 3. Fasten pivot with #8 x 2½" deck screw provided.
- 4. Snap Discovery Telescope onto pivot.





- Position rocks at desired location.
- 2. Mark pilot holes.
- 3. Drill %" holes completely through boards.
- 4. Hammer in T-nuts from back side.
- 5. Secure with two ¼" x 1" machine screws and ¼" split lock washers provided.
